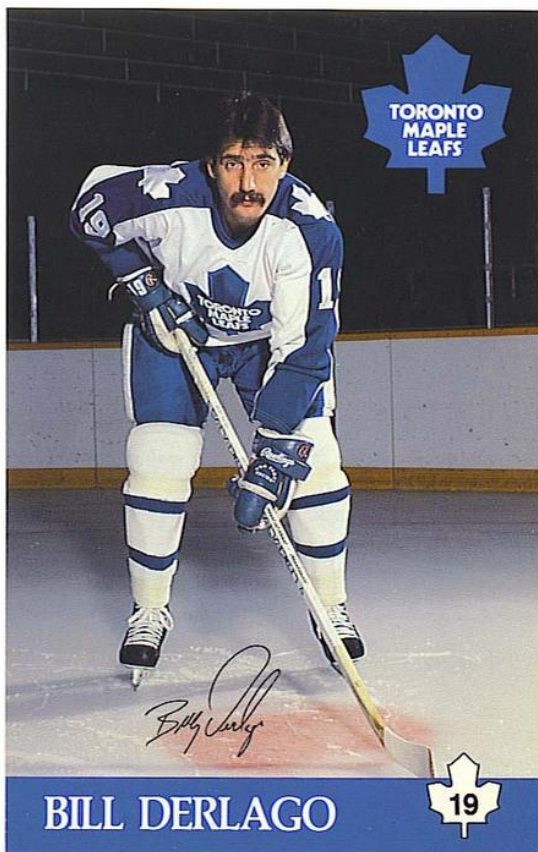




BILL DERLAGO

Sniper Bill Derlago has joined the Road Hockey to Conquer Cancer team!

A junior sensation with the Brandon Wheat Kings, Bill Derlago enjoyed consecutive seasons with 49, 96 and 89 goals. He made his NHL debut with the Vancouver Canucks in 1978-79. In February 1980, Derlago and Rick Vaive were traded to Toronto for Tiger Williams and Jerry Butler, and it was as a Leaf that Bill had his finest years. In five full seasons, he scored 30 or more goals four times, including a 40-goal season in 1983-84. After a single game at the start of the 1985-86 season, Bill was traded to the Boston Bruins, but then finished the season with the Winnipeg Jets. His NHL career concluded in 1986-87 with a season split between the Jets and the Quebec Nordiques. An Honoured Member in the Manitoba Hockey Hall of Fame, Bill Derlago's NHL totals include 189 goals and 416 points in 555 regular season games.
