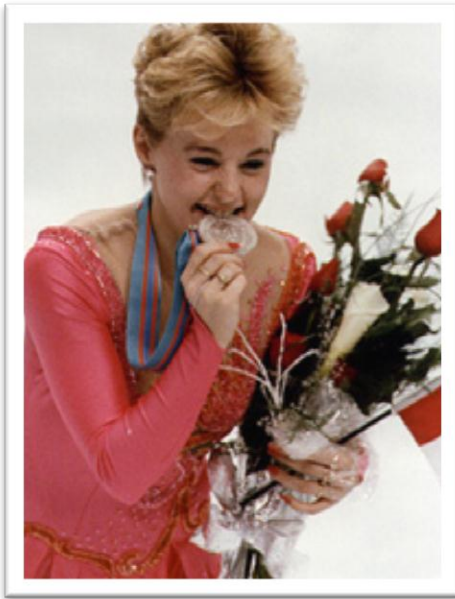




ELIZABETH MANLEY

Liz Manley's sensational figure skating has made her a national hero. While she competed in the Olympic Winter Games in 1984, it was at the Calgary Games in 1988 that Liz really gained prominence. Although battling illness, Liz was in third place after the compulories and the short program, sitting behind Debi Thomas of the United States and Katarina Witt of East Germany, both favoured in various camps to win the gold medal. In the long program, Liz outskated both with an electrifying program that lifted her score to with a fraction of a point of beating Katarina Witt and allowed her to pass Debi Thomas. The country

roared its approval as the astonished (and beaming) Canadian accepted a silver medal, making her an instant national celebrity.
