Team USA Olympic bronze medallist Kathleen Kauth has joined the Road Hockey To Conquer Cancer team!

A native of Saratoga Springs, New York, Kathleen Kauth earned a bronze medal at the 2006 Winter Olympics while playing with Team USA. Currently playing in the CWHL, Kathleen's hockey heritage includes captaining the Brown University Women's Hockey team in 2001 and competing for the United States in the 2004 and 2005 World Championships, earning a gold medal at the latter tournament. Postponing medical school to play for her country in the 2006 Olympic Games in Turin, Kathleen went on to earn her Masters

in Public Health at Boston University and while doing research at The Hospital for Sick Children, joined the Brampton Thunder of the CWHL.
