



KEVIN MAGUIRE

Former Toronto Maple Leaf tough guy Kevin Maguire has joined the Road Hockey to Conquer Cancer team!

Kevin Maguire joined the Toronto Maple Leafs in 1986-87 and although he played in just 17 games, he collected 74 penalty minutes. Plucked off the waiver wire by the Buffalo Sabres the next season, Kevin enjoyed his best season in 1988-89 when he scored 8 goals and 18 points, a whopping 241 minutes in penalties and was a +9. At the trade deadline in 1989-90, Kevin was sent to the Philadelphia Flyers. That brief stop was followed by a return engagement with the Leafs that concluded in 1991-92. In 260 regular season NHL games, Kevin Maguire

earned 59 points and collected 782 penalty minutes. Following his playing career, Maguire pursued a career as a referee and returned to the NHL as an on-ice official in 1999-2000.
