Longtime CTV sports anchor Lance Brown has joined the Road Hockey to Conquer Cancer team!

Lance Brown has been a sports anchor on CTV News Toronto since arriving in our city in 1985, and today, he also serves as CTV Toronto's sports director. After stops at BCTV Vancouver, CKCK-TV Regina and CITV Edmonton, Lance was hired by CFTO-TV Toronto, now known as CTV News Toronto. Over his long career in sports broadcasting, Lance's career highlights include coverage of the Olympic Games in Calgary in 1988, Barcelona in 1992 and Lillehammer in 1994. His favourite interview with a sports personality is Wayne Gretzky, who was just 17 at the time they first spoke. In 1995, Lance won a Canpro Award for Inside Blue Jays Baseball. Other career highlights include hosting NHL broadcasts in Edmonton, doing football and baseball play-by-play, calling track and field at the Olympics and calling Jean-Luc Brassard's gold medal in freestyle skiing at the Olympic Games in Lillehammer.
