CTV News reporter Michelle Dubé has joined the Road Hockey to Conquer Cancer team!

From her days of playing TV anchor as a child, it was clear that broadcasting was in Michelle Dubé's future. A California native, Michelle volunteered at various cable television stations before landing a position as the voice of The Beat, an online music show streamed in 30 U.S. states. She earned a degree from the University of Western Ontario's Media Information and Technoculture program while concurrently receiving a diploma in broadcast journalism from Fanshawe College. While in London, Michelle earned experience with that city's AM980 CFPL, FM96 and 103.1 FRESH-FM. In 2007, Michelle joined Hamilton's CHCH Television as a news reporter and soon had the opportunity to anchor weekend newscasts. Later, she co-anchored CHCH's evening newscast, making her one of the youngest news

anchors in Canada. In April 2009, Michelle Dubé joined CTV News Toronto, Toronto's number one newscast, as a reporter.
