Former Maple Leaf Mike Pelyk has joined the Road Hockey To Conquer Cancer team!

Mike Pelyk joined the Maple Leafs the year after they last won the Stanley Cup, and spent nine seasons, served in two stints, with his hometown team. The swift-skating defenceman brought hard-hitting defence and a flourish of offence to the Leafs from his debut in 1967-68 through to his retirement after the 1977-78 campaign. For two seasons, Mike played in the World Hockey Association, spending 1974-75 with the Vancouver Blazers and 1975-76 captaining the Cincinnati Stingers before returning to the Leafs for the

1976-77 season. A cancer survivor himself, Mike Pelyk has also served as president of the Toronto Maple Leafs Alumni Association.
