Former Leafs' winger Pat Boutette has joined the Road Hockey to Conquer Cancer team!

An All-American All-Star in 1973, Pat Boutette turned pro while attending the University of Minnesota. In 1975-76, he made his NHL debut with the Toronto Maple Leafs and quickly established himself as a tireless forward who could contribute offensively as well as drop the gloves when the situation arose. During his fifth season in Toronto, Pat was traded to the Hartford Whalers and in 1980-81, enjoyed a career-year, scoring 28 goals and collecting 80 points in 80 games. He was traded to the Pittsburgh Penguins the next season and continued to play his aggressive game. In 1984-85, he was traded mid-season back to the Whalers where he concluded his NHL career.
